IT'S A MALARKEY MYSTERY!

It's the 9th Big Malarkey Festival AND the National Year of Reading so we're very excited to welcome all of our Hull Libraries Schools back to Malarkey Park to celebrate reading, making art, having fun, writing rhymes, exploring mysteries, solving riddles, designing disguises, and enjoying illustration, music, dance and drama together.

Inspired by the mystery theme, this year we've got an amazing programme of workshops.

We can't wait to welcome our amazing authors **Michelle Robinson, Philippa Leathley and Sharna Jackson.**

We're also delighted to be working with amazing artists including Hull Truck Theatre, Squarepeg Arts, Mambo Jambo, The Herd, Reel Creative CIC, Rewilding Youth, Pauline Quirk Academy, Half Frame Full Flavour, Tasneem Kausar, Liz Million and Hull Makerspace.

The aim of The Big Malarkey Festival is to encourage reading for pleasure and engagement with everything that the library has to offer – all kinds of books, of course, and creative workshops and experiences too.

The 2026 school activity days will provide workshops which encourage and inspire the children to use their imaginations, practice problem solving, develop their critical thinking skills, enjoy sharing stories and ideas, and discover their own creative power through working alongside professional artists.

As always, we value your feedback and encourage you to encourage your pupils to *keep using their library to discover and feel inspired!*

HOW TO BOOK

- ★ You can book individual classes for *either* the morning session *or* the afternoon session - the afternoon session is a repeat of the morning. Your class ticket entitles you to 2 x 45 minute practical workshops. 1 class = 30 pupils.
- ★ Booking opens on Wednesday 25 March and is on a first-come-first-served basis - so get booking as soon as you can!
- ★ Email HullSchoolsLibrary@hcandl.co.uk to book your sessions. State your:
 - preferred days
 - whether you would like the morning or afternoon session
 - the two workshops you would like to book
 - how many classes you will be bringing and the number of children in the class
- ★ To maximise the opportunities for all schools, we ask that you book a maximum of three class tickets per school over the week. 1 class = 30 pupils.
- ★ **CAPACITY:** Please take note of the maximum capacity of each event / workshop and ensure you book the correct number of children. We will ask you to confirm the number when you make your booking.
- ★ After you have booked your events, we will write to you to confirm your place and send you further details of the day.

THE FESTIVAL SITE: MALARKEY PARK



The festival takes place in *Malarkey Park*, our colourful tented village in East Park, Holderness Road, Hull, HU8 8JU.

THE MYSTERY FILES

TASNEEM KAUSAR

In this fun and creative workshop, artist Tasneem Kausar introduces children to the technique of colour separation, showing how light and colour can hide and reveal secrets.

Children will learn step by step how to draw a character, add a hidden word, and disguise their picture using red marker. Making special-coloured filters as 'spy tools', they will then reveal the hidden images and messages and try to decode each other's mystery cards.

Each child will take home an A5 'Mystery File' to keep their secret drawings, while discovering in a playful way that sometimes you need to look at things differently to uncover something new.

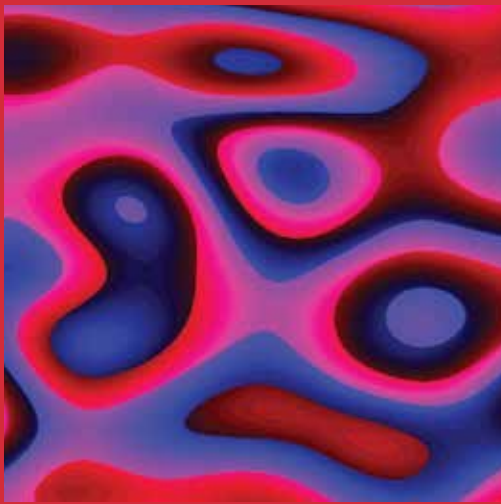
WHAT ON EARTH!

AI NEWSREADER

REEL CREATIVE, HELLO U CREATIVE AND INIT CREATIVE

In this engaging workshop, young people will learn about AI avatars and how they are being used in media to present information and tell stories. Through clear examples and short demonstrations, participants explore how AI-generated characters communicate messages and influence how content is perceived.

Using simple prompts, young people create their own AI characters and see how AI avatars can be used to share stories. The workshop also introduces topics such as fake news, deepfakes, and critical thinking, encouraging discussion about trust, truth, and how digital content is created.

The session is designed to be accessible and age-appropriate, with a focus on awareness, creativity, and ethical thinking rather than technical detail. It links to computing, spoken language, and media literacy, helping young people better understand AI in a familiar, real-world context.

Along the way, Sharna explains how great mysteries work, breaking down people, plot and place and sharing practical tips to help shape a story that makes sense and keeps readers guessing.

Perfect for curious readers and budding writers, this is a lively, creative session where ideas are shared, decisions are made together, and a mystery comes to life in real time.

BRINGING PHAROHS TO LIFE!

REEL CREATIVE, HELLO U CREATIVE AND INIT CREATIVE

In this engaging workshop, children explore Ancient Egypt through storytelling, symbols, and imagination. They learn how Ancient Egyptians used hieroglyphics as one of the earliest forms of communication and compare these symbols with how we communicate today.

Children decorate a pharaoh's headdress using traditional patterns and designs, before seeing the pharaoh come to life using AI and augmented reality, where the character speaks and shares a short story.

Technology is used in a simple, purposeful way, with the focus on creativity and discussion. The session supports learning across history, art, spoken language, and computing, making the past feel exciting and accessible.

Drake Music is a national charity that makes music accessible to Disabled people using accessible instruments and technology. Our vision is a world where Disabled and Non-Disabled people can make music together as equals.

This year we're inviting local SEN/D specialist schools to take part in one of two fun and accessible creative music making workshops delivered by Drake Music. Each workshop will last for the whole morning or afternoon, ensuring plenty of time to explore accessible instruments and technology, share ideas, and to have fun creating our own new music together! Session breaks will be co-ordinated to match the other workshops taking place on site.

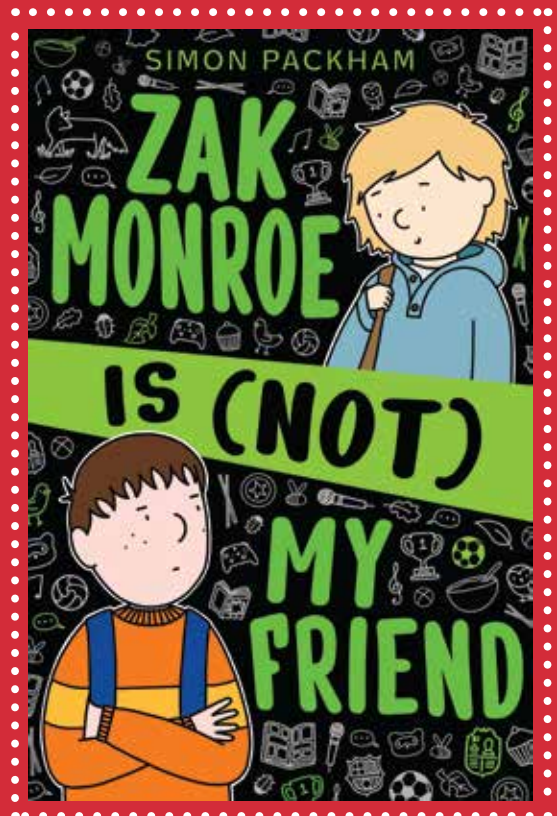

MAKE THE MALARKEY FUN LAST ALL DAY WITH A VISIT TO THE EAST PARK ANIMAL EDUCATION CENTRE

Why not spend half the day at The Big Malarkey Festival and the other half enjoying fun workshops at East Park Animal Centre?

Animal Centre visits will support the school curriculum, last approximately 90 minutes and can be adapted to meet the bespoke needs of your school group. Workshops visits can also be combined and enhanced with an exclusive 30-minute keeper talk. East Park Animal Centre workshop options are listed below and include exclusive access to the Animal Centre for your school class.

EYFS / KS1 WORKSHOPS – PLEASE CHOOSE FROM THE SESSIONS BELOW:

■ MYSTERIOUS MINI-BEASTS

Focus: Understanding the World / Mathematics

In this story and craft session, we will take a closer look at creepy crawlies, exploring the bugs that live at the zoo and that we may find in our own back yard. Children will have the opportunity to participate in mini-beast activities and crafts to help discover the mysteries behind these tiny, misunderstood creatures.

■ CREATURE COLOUR DETECTIVES

Focus: Understanding the World / Science / Expressive Arts and Design

In this interactive story and art session, children will learn about life in the rainforest and discover why some creatures prefer to stand out from the crowd. Children will be given the chance to explore the mysteries and meanings behind the types of colourings used by animals and link them to the animals in our zoo. They will have the opportunity to take part in their own colourful animal craft.

■ HABITAT INVESTIGATIONS

Focus: Science / Citizenship

This multi-activity workshop will allow children to explore how different animals are suited to live in their habitats and discover how the zoo meets the needs of the animals that live there. Children will learn about what animals need to survive and thrive and consider how we can begin to support wildlife in our local area. *This workshop can be adapted to focus on a specific environment, if required.*

■ NATURE DETECTIVES:

Focus: Science / Numeracy / Geography

Focus: Science / Art

In this exciting and interactive session, students will be able to take a closer look at animal anatomy and explore the differences and similarities within different creatures, we will investigate links to evolution, adaptation, and animal groupings, making connections to the animals from around the zoo.

■ WHO GOES WHERE?

Focus: Science / Art

Classification is the key to understanding the natural world. In this interactive, multi-activity workshop, children will be given the opportunity to explore the different classifications within nature, making links to animals within our zoo. Children will create their own classification keys and work together to test their theories around the site.

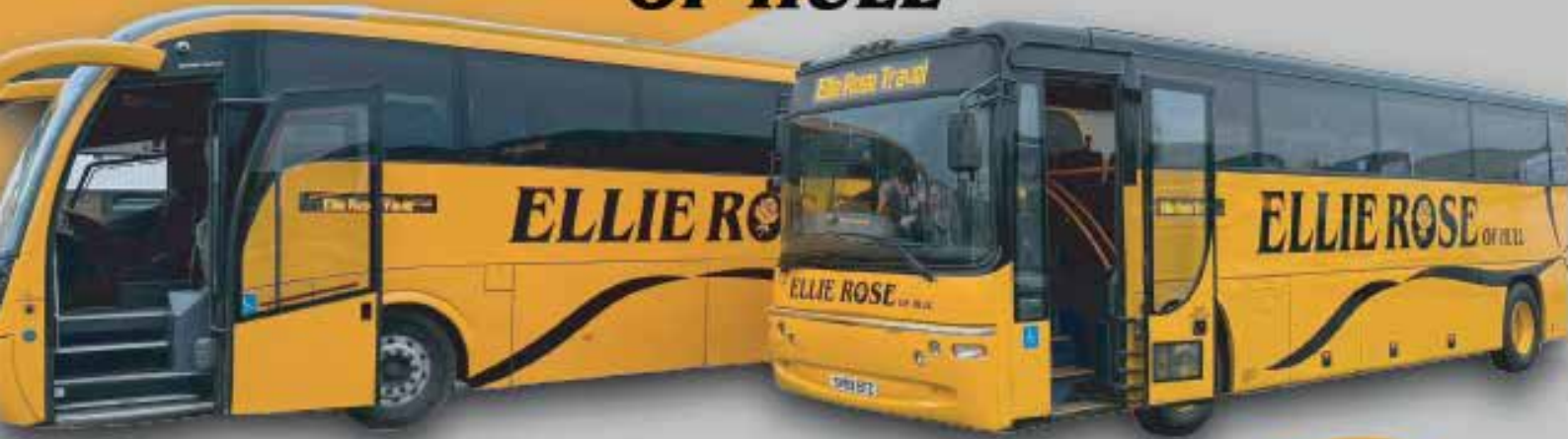
